

****Failed to pass******SF 456 – General – Regional Water Board**Position: **Monitor**

This bill would dismantle the Des Moines Water Works and replaces it with a regional water board, with representation from each municipality served.

Status: **3/31- On Senate floor (FM: Zumbach (R))**Notes: Successor to SSB 1146, Companion to HF 484

****Bill sent to Governor for passage******SF 500 – Telecom – E911 CHANGES**Position: **Monitor**

This bill would change E911 references in the Code to 911 references and remove enhanced references. It would also require DHS/EM to develop a plan for combining the wireline 911 with the next generation 911 network.

Status: **4/21- Passed House 96-0**

Notes: Successor to SF 454, SSB 1082

****Bill sent to Governor for passage******SF 502 – Credit Unions – Consumer credit transactions**Position: **Support**

This bill would establish charges and penalties related to certain consumer credit transactions.

Status: **4/17- Passed House 96-2**

4/12- Passed Senate 49-0

Notes: Successor to SF 418, SSB 1118

****Bill sent to Governor for passage******SF 503 – Credit Unions – Consumer credit transactions**Position: **Support**

This bill would allow a deferral of unpaid installments on interest-bearing consumer credit transactions.

Status: **4/17- Passed House 95-4**

4/12- Passed Senate 49-0

Notes: Successor to SF 177, SSB 1016; Companion to HF 629 (withdrawn)

****Failed to pass******SF 512 – General – Water Quality**Position: **Support**

This bill would create and a *Water Quality Infrastructure Fund* funded by Iowa gaming receipts, and establish a *Water Quality Financing Program* funded by creating a water service excise tax and a related sales tax exemption

Status: **4/21- Passed Senate 31-19, but did not pass House**Notes: Successor to SF 482, SSB 1034

****Failed to pass****

HF 117 – General – Flood/Erosion Control Tax

Position: **Monitor**

This bill would apply, to all taxable property, the local assessment option currently imposed on only agricultural property for flood/erosion control.

Status: **2/07- House Ways and Means Subcommittee: Kaufmann, Nunn and Wolfe**

****Failed to pass****

HF 484 – General – Regional Water Board

Position: **Monitor**

This bill would dismantle the Des Moines Water Works and replaces it with a regional water board, with representation from each municipality served.

Status: **3/30- Placed on House calendar under unfinished business (FM: Klein (R))**

Notes: Successor to HF 316, Companion to HF 456

****Bill withdrawn****

HF 612 – General – Water Quality

Position: **Support**

This bill would appropriate \$229 million from the RIIF (Rebuild Iowa Infrastructure Fund) over 13 years for water quality projects. Contains an exchange program for water quality credits.

Status: **4/21- Withdrawn due to adoption of SF 512**

4/05- House Appropriations Subcommittee: Deyoe, Bearinger and Rogers

Notes: Successor to HF 538, HSB 135

HF 617 – General – Ag Omnibus

Position: **Monitor**

This bill would make several changes including pesticide dealer fees & amendments to the Iowa Fertilizer Law.

Status: **4/19- Passed Senate 50-0**

4/04- Passed House 98-0

Notes: Successor to HF 550, HSB 120

****Failed to pass****

HF 638 – General – Secretary of State Document Filing

Position: **Monitor**

This bill would make changes to facilitate the filing of business documents electronically.

Status: **4/13- On House Ways and Means Committee calendar**

Notes: Possible vessel for a central lien filing amendment

Successor to HSB 180

****Passed into law****

SF 447 – General – Ag Nuisance

Position: **Monitor**

This bill would aim to create legal protections from ag nuisance lawsuits.

Status: **3/29- Signed into law by Governor Branstad**

3/22- Passed House 90-39

3/14- Passed Senate 31-18

Notes: Successor to SSB 1144, Companion to HF 468

****Passed into law****

SF 331 – Electric Cooperatives – Report Efficiency

Position: **Support**

This bill would allow RECs to file a shorter, federal energy form in lieu of the longer Iowa Utilities Board version.

Status: **3/22- Signed into law by Governor Branstad**

3/13- Passed House 95-0

3/09- Passed Senate 48-0
