Director Certification Program (DCP) 2019 Registration Information

We will be hosting all four phases of our Director Certification Program (DCP) the week of January 29th - February 1st. In the past two years, we updated and revised the format of the program so please read this entire letter to make sure your directors are familiar with the new format.

We will begin the program on Tuesday, January 29th at 1:00. This program will be held at Kings Pointe Resort in Storm Lake. We will begin the day with Phase IV. In this session, we discuss communication with and evaluation of the General Manager. Dr. Greg McKee, University of Nebraska, will lead this session. He will be joined by retired Aspinwall Co-op general manager Randy Behrens. Following the conclusion of the afternoon session, we will have dinner together at Kings Pointe Resort. After dinner, we will be joined by Tim Dvorak with Associated Benefits Corporation. Tim is going to discuss compensation methods of General Managers and broad compensation ranges.

We will begin the second day on Wednesday, January 30th with Phase III. In this phase we discuss and review the financial statements of local cooperatives. Dr. Keri Jacob, ISU economist and IIC Endowed Economics Professor, will lead the discussion with CoBank relationship representative Troy Collins. We will review a balance sheet, income statement and a source and use of working capital. The attendees will be completing some exercises and discussion of what key financial ratios they should be monitoring and what the impact of these statements could be. We will break for lunch and conclude our discussion of cooperative financial statements by 2:00 and send the directors on their way home

We will begin our next session on Thursday, January 31st at The Hilton Garden Inn in Cedar Falls at 1:00. Dr. Keri Jacobs will lead the first afternoon session as we begin with Phase I and look at the historical perspective of cooperatives and the cooperative business model. During our second afternoon session, Eric Eide, Nyemaster Goode, will discuss with your directors their legal responsibilities and obligations in their role on the local cooperative Board of Directors. At the conclusion of the afternoon, we will be having dinner together at The Hilton Garden Inn. After dinner Dr. Jacobs, will complete Phase I with discussion on director's role and responsibilities in the success of your local cooperative. She will look specifically at the separation of duties of the board and the general manager.

We will conclude the Cedar Falls session Friday morning beginning at 8:00 with Phase II. In this phase we discuss strategic planning, why it is so critical to your success and the director's role in this process. Dr. Greg McKee and Brad Olemann, former CEO of United Suppliers and COO of Land O'Lakes will spend the morning leading the directors in this discussion of strategic planning and how to best complete this process. We will conclude the session at Noon and make lunch available to the attendees and then send them on their way home.
